Here we are in May already and we are gearing up for the **May Long Weekend Market** here in Invermere. The stall numbers have been freshly painted, this year in **YELLOW** so you will have no trouble finding your stall.

The stall allocation list is attached as well as the market layout

Many of you have been in the market before but we have some new vendors this year. Here are some of the basics about Market Day

Usually, on the Thursday before the market the allocated stall numbers are published on our website;

On market day arrive at the market area from 7.00 am, allowing enough time to set up your tent and stall to be ready for the market starting at 9.00 am. The market guys will be at the market to direct and answer any questions you might have.

For the vendors with single stalls please locate your stall, unload your vehicle, park your vehicle, and then set up your stall. When unloading, keep as far to the side to allow others to pass. We would like traffic to proceed from the 6th avenue side towards the ice arena.

Please refrain from parking in front of the stores on 7th ave (Main street) and 13 street (Manulife to BC Liquor store). The stores in our town need these parking spots for their customers. Park behind or in front of the Eddie Mountain Memorial arena.

No vehicles in the market from 08:45 am – 1:15 pm! We request that you do not start breaking down your stall until 1.00 pm.

At 1:15 pm all vehicles are allowed to enter the market area for loading, nose in and roll in stall vendors may leave the market area. Please be kind and watch out for other vendors and articles.

ALL vendors are responsible for removing litter from their stall. We insist that you take all refuse and recyclables with you and not deposit it in the grey and blue bins, these are for market visitors.

All vendors have a Vendor ID number, this to help the admin side of things. Please use your vendor number in all communications.
